Chalk painted Candle sticks

Introduction



I bought these two wooden candle holders . They looked tired and the wood was stained meaning it would be very difficult to re oil or put a wood finish on as would look tatty. The wood turning looked really good so though these had some good days in front of them.

Step one

First i gave a light sand and cleaned . There were no traces of oil or wood finish left.

Step two

I painted a coat of a Da Vinci's Chalk paint in a muddy beige look which looked quite nice.

I let dry which took about 20 minutes.

Step three

I then painted a coat of Da Vinci's Chalk finish paint over the beige and allowed about 2-3 minutes to tack off then dabbed gently with a damp rag.

I made a couple of mistakes and took too much white off but just brushed on more white and dabbed again with white rag.

Step four

I then applied a coat of Only Greens "eco wax" in clear. This gave the candle sticks a nice satin look.
